KPHO-TV's Sarah Buduson Receives Inaugural Freedom's Voice™ Award

June 2, 2010, Gilbert, AZ -- Sarah Buduson of Phoenix Channel 5 (KPHO, a CBS affiliate) is the recipient of Knife Rights' first Freedom's Voice™ Award. The honor will be formally announced at the Sharper Future™ Awards Breakfast on June 5th at the BLADE Show in Atlanta, Georgia.

The annual Freedom's Voice™ Award will honor a journalist or journalistic team in general media that has demonstrated a commitment to fair, accurate and insightful coverage on an issue involving knife ownership.

Knife Rights chairman Doug Ritter said, "Ms. Buduson is recognized for her reporting about our efforts to pass Knife Law Preemption (SB1153) in Arizona. Effectively and creatively illustrating the key issues, Ms. Buduson's 'Arizona Knife Rights Under Review In Legislature' presented a balanced perspective."

Knife Rights believes its goals to preserve and enhance the rights of knife owners make sense to most citizens, if given a fair airing.
