ELIGIBILITY
You must be an individual charter member of Knife Rights, inc. (KRI) who joined between January 9, 2007 and March 9, 2007. You must be at least 18 years or older at the time of the drawing. All winners will be notified in writing or by phone of the prize won and any requisite procedure to claim the prize. All prizes will be sent to the winner's listed membership address only.

Winners' names and locations by city or town, and state, may be mailed to all entrants and may also be posted at www.KnifeRights.org.
