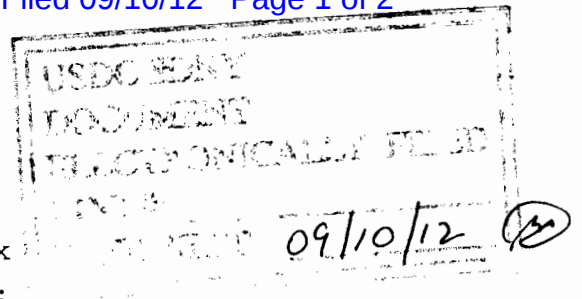

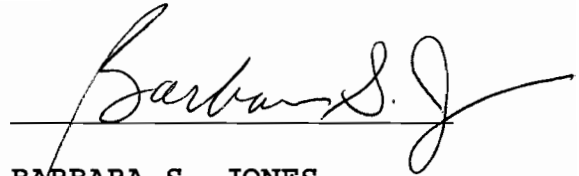

Defendant Cyrus Vance, Jr., ("Vance") filed a motion to dismiss the instant action on October 12, 2011. Defendant the City of New York (the "City") filed a motion for judgment on the pleadings on December 16, 2011. On May 23, 2012, Plaintiffs John Copeland, Knife Rights, Inc., and Pedro Perez (collectively "Plaintiffs") filed a motion for leave to file an amended complaint. On September 7, 2012, Magistrate Judge Ronald Ellis granted Plaintiffs' motion to amend.

In light of the decision of the magistrate judge, this Court now **DENIES** as moot Vance's motion to dismiss and the City's motion for judgment on the pleadings.

The Clerk of the Court is directed to terminate motions #16 and #31 from the ECF docket.
